Luke 19:13.

I'm reminded of Paul in his final words to the brethren of Ephesus, when he commended them to God, as we read in Acts 20:32:

And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the Word of His grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified..

Ultimately, there is great joy and confidence for the true believer -- that we are always in God's care -- He is the One who will build us up, even as we prepare for His return. And yet, just as the men of Ephesus were extremely sad because they were not going to see Paul again, we, too, must push forward, knowing that God's perfect will is at hand:

And they all wept sore, and fell on Paul's neck, and kissed him, Sorrowing most of all for the words which he spake, that they should see his face no more. And they accompanied him unto the ship. Acts 20:37 & 38


Even though the Apostle Paul sorrowfully bid his farewell to those he ministered to and cared for, he pushed on.
